
Fokker V.9 RS Model resin kit

The Fokker V.9 was a prototype for the D.VI fighter. Main difference between the V.9 and the V.13/1 (the actual prototype for the D.VI) was that the V.9 had V-styles between the wings and the V.13-I N-styles. The V.13/1 had also a larger wing area. The V.9 has flown with the Oberursel U 0 and Ur II rotary engines.

The kit contains resin parts, photo-etched parts for seat belt, cockpit stairs, propeller hub and instrument panel, instrument dials printed on a clear plastic sheet, a set of decals and an instruction sheet.

The instruction sheet is very extensive. It contains a history of the aircraft, a five-view drawing, extensive painting instructions and two exploded views and is sufficient to build the model.

Grosz (ref. 1) and Weyl (ref. 2) and Engels (ref. 6 and 7) report dimensions, Weyl shows also a side view of the aircraft and Engels a three view drawing.

Armament

The kit provides two options for the engine: the seven cylinder Oberursel U 0 and the nine cylinder Ur II. I have built the version with the Ur II.

Modifications to the model

I have not detailed the Ur II engine. Handling points at rear part of fuselage made of 0.4 mm brass wire. Bracing of undercarriage. Painting scheme?
